2024 Rosé Gibson Ranch Mendocino County

Our friend, a true legend and saint, Bob Gibson lent his hand to press these grapes. Not only did he grow them but, when it came to deliver them, he jumped out of the truck and rolled up his sleeves to help finish the job.

This Rosé has seen between 8 and 9 hours of skin contact before being pressed then fermented in stainless steel. It takes a steely eye and a firm hand to gauge the right time to press, although it is better to be lucky than good... but why not be both? Indeed this is a beauty to behold. Delicious and light-hearted but produced with all the serious care and attention to voluptuous detail for which our wines are legendary. The color is simply stunning, reminiscent of a wedding, and beautiful, in a Goldilocks manner: not too pink but just pink enough. And the fruit flavors of watermelon and alpine strawberry are beautifully balanced by bright and tight acidity and a dry and savory aspect that keeps those fruits in line. Serve cool but not cold; after all, the night is still young.
